

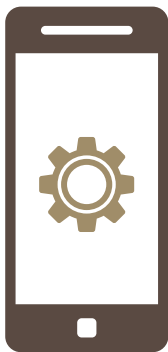

How to Enable iCloud 2-Step Verification



- On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch with iOS 9 or later:
- Go to Settings > iCloud > tap your Apple ID
- Tap password & Security
- Click on "Set Up Two-Factor Authentication"
- You will be brought to a page explaining what two-factor authentication does.
- Click "Continue"



- On your Mac with OS X El Capitan or later:
- Go to Apple menu > System Preferences > iCloud > Account Details
- Click Security
- Click Turn on Two-Factor Authentication



- In either instance, you will need at least one trusted phone number on file where you can receive verification codes
- To set this up:
- Go to your Apple ID account page
- Sign in with your Apple ID
- Go to the Devices Section and click "Add a Trusted Phone Number" and enter the phone number you would like to add
- Choose to verify the number with a text or phone call, and click Continue
